

Additional Benefits Supporting Residency/Fellowship

Meals

A Meal stipend is provided to each resident for use while on service – amount determined annually.

Uniforms

White coats and scrubs are provided for all members of the resident staff.

Professional Development and Scholarly Work

Fellows (and Residents beginning their R2 year) are eligible for financial assistance to attend and/or present scholarly work at medical meetings. To be eligible to receive financial assistance. Presenting scholarly work at professional meetings within the continental United States will be reimbursed for travel expenses, consistent with that allowed by the medical center, for at least one presentation per topic per year.

State Licensure and DEA Certification

The medical center reimburses for “limited” licensure fee in the state of Washington while in the training program. Two years of postgraduate training are required for permanent licensure in the state of Washington. DEA certification is also reimbursed by Virginia Mason.

Parking

Parking for all members of the house staff is provided by the medical center while on service.

Photocopying/Notary/Poster Production

Photocopying and other services related to production of materials needed during training period for educational purposes will be provided by the medical center, upon approval of program leadership.
