Review all blood thinning medications or supplements. If you take Blood Thinning medications, or aspirin at the recommendation of your Family Doctor or Cardiologist, you will be instructed regarding how and when to stop this medication by a member of your care team. You must talk with a Urology Nurse to confirm plan 10 days prior to procedure. Do not ride a motorcycle or bicycle. An enema is not required.
