Since the Sisters of St. Francis of Philadelphia founded St. Joseph Hospital in 1891 (now St. Joseph Medical Center), CHI Franciscan Health has grown with the enduring goal of fulfilling the spiritual, emotional and physical needs of those we serve. In keeping with the values of St. Francis of Assisi, the Sisters of St. Francis ministered to all people, regardless of race, religion or financial status. St. Joseph Hospital, Tacoma's first Catholic hospital, opened with 60 beds. Eight years later, it expanded to 200 beds to meet the growing need for services. Over the years, CHI Franciscan has expanded and affiliated with other systems to become what it is today, which includes eight hospitals and over 200 locations across the Pacific Northwest.

Although we are significantly larger, our mission and core values remain the same.

The spirit of giving and caring is evident every day at CHI Franciscan through our many volunteers and our physicians and employees who go above and beyond. 



Building a culture of continued growth and development

This year Franciscan Foundation awarded \$63,500 to 23 employees pursuing undergraduate or graduate degrees through the Franciscan Scholarship program. Scholarships are made possible by generous donors who are committed to ensuring our employees have access to furthering their educational goals.

One recipient, **Shelley Rhone**, is completing her Bachelor in Science Nursing degree at the Western Governors University. Shelley has been part of CHI Franciscan Health for over 25 years. As an RN Care Manager in the St. Clare Hospital Emergency Department, she is caring for our community's most vulnerable patients, connecting them with local social services programs to help them stay healthy once they are discharged. In pursuing her degree Shelley said:

"I cannot image wanting any other career besides nursing. I not only want to get a degree, I want to learn as much as possible to help me become a better nurse. I want to take my experience and additional education and contribute to the continued growth of CHI Franciscan in the Pacific Northwest."

A compassionate approach

Committed to caring for the whole person

Franciscan Hospice & Palliative Care is the largest hospice provider in Washington, offering comprehensive end-of-life hospice care to patients and their families throughout King, Kitsap and Pierce Counties.

Every day, our dedicated team of highly trained professionals help people live each day with dignity and comfort. In FY17, your generosity allowed us to provide more than \$900,000 to support hospice programs and projects.

One of the programs funded through community support is Comfort Therapy. These therapies can reduce pain and stress and help create a sense of calm. Services include:

Massage Therapy: Intentional touch for patients provided by a massage therapist. In some cases the family will join in and offer gentle comforting touch. Massage also helps to decrease anxiety.

Music Therapy: Music can touch the soul in ways that words cannot. Our music therapists bring a variety of instruments to the bedside, including voice. Music from a particular era that the patient grew up in can bring joy and comfort.

Hypnotherapy: Guided meditation to a favorite place that can help with pain control or anxiety.

Art Therapy: Art activities tailored to the patient and his or her physical abilities that can offer a refuge from stress, pain and anxiety; help with the expression of emotions; stimulate memory; and provide relief from isolation and boredom.

Aromatherapy: The use of essential oils to reduce stress, to balance and increase one's sense of wellbeing, and to treat physical and mental ailments.

Franciscan Foundation grants bring comfort, care and critical help

Did you know that the Franciscan Foundation and its Board of Trustees utilize unrestricted earnings on investments to provide financial support for a wide range of other non-profit agencies in the communities served by CHI Franciscan Health whose mission and goals are consistent with the healthy-community-building goals of CHI Franciscan Health?

In fiscal year 2017, the Franciscan Foundation provided \$363,000 in grants to AHAT Homecare, Boys & Girls Clubs of South Puget Sound, Carol Milgard Breast Center, Catherine Place, Catholic Community Services of W Washington, Children's Museum of Tacoma, Communities in Schools, Emergency Food Network, Family Justice Center Foundation, Foundation for Tacoma Students (Graduate Tacoma), Goodwill of Olympic & Rainier Region, Healing Places, Hilltop, Artists, Lindquist Dental Center, Mountain View Community Center, New Phoebe House, NW Furniture Bank, Perinatal Collaborative of Pierce County, Pierce County Library Foundation, Rescue Mission, Safe Streets, Smile Partners, Society of St. Vincent de Paul at St. Theresa's, Sound Outreach, Step by Step, The First Tee, and YWCA RAGS.

One program we are proud to support is the Northwest Furniture Bank. The Northwest Furniture Bank services over 1,500 families each year who are in crisis and at a juncture in their lives when they need a helping hand to gain stability. A grant from the Franciscan Foundation helps support operating costs to ensure that NW Furniture Bank is able to provide the basic needs of donated furniture and housewares to low income families who have been able to secure housing but have no furniture.
