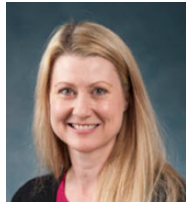

Course description

Human papillomavirus (HPV), which is a widespread and serious sexually transmitted disease, is now established as the principle cause of 70% of all head and neck cancers. Early recognition of potential complications of all head and neck treatment modalities will improve the quality of life and survivorship outcomes. This interactive, case-study based CME program is presented by an expert faculty panel who will address the epidemiology of HPV infection and its relationship to P-16 positive head and neck cancer. The program will review the most common approaches to treatment, the differences in staging, discuss the importance of early speech and swallow evaluations, nutritional interventions and cancer prevention strategies.
