Instructions for studies with moderate sedation.

MRI (Magnetic Resonance Imaging) utilizes radio frequencies and magnetic fields to produce images of the bdy that are in thin slices. These slices provide high resolution images of both bone and soft tissues. Depending on the type of scan your physician has requested, you may be given an injection of IV contrast (dye) as part of your exam.
